

2019 Annual Meeting Preparations

A committee has been formed to plan the Circle D Civic Association 2019 Annual Meeting. Committee members are Theol Jackman, Chair, Sue Pardue, Kathy Kincheloe, Susan Green and Carol Schumacher. As the committee begins planning, we would appreciate suggestions for putting together the agenda and scheduling guest speakers. Guests in the past have included the County Commissioner, Bastrop County Fire, the Sheriff's Office, the Texas A & M Forest Service, among others.

Did you know that the by-laws require that the meeting be held on any Saturday in March, April or May? And that it must be between 10:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. The committee is working on setting a date and location and will send out a notice once that is decided.

Elections for the board of directors will be held at the meeting. There are currently four positions up for election, three of which are occupied and one of which is vacant. Per the Bylaws, one tenth (1/10) of the membership constitutes a quorum when counting votes. You can be nominated by someone or you can nominate yourself to run for a position on the board. Nominations will be open 60 days prior to the Annual Meeting. Candidates must submit a short biographical note, no longer than 250 words, which will be presented to the Association. Names will be listed in alphabetical order and the persons receiving the largest number of votes shall be elected. An election judge who is neither a CDCA member nor a representative of the Association's management will oversee the election process. The [Bylaws](#) detail the procedures for casting votes and the election process.

If you are interested in running for the board, please remember that these are volunteer positions and that meetings are on the second Saturday of the month. To serve on the board you must be a member in good standing, which means current on paying your maintenance fees (annual dues). Furthermore, any person who was convicted of a felony or a crime of moral turpitude is disqualified from continued or future service on the Circle D Civic Association Board for twenty (20) years following the date of such conviction.
